- Learn current research in reading, writing and oral language applicable across content areas K-12, in inclusive classrooms and schools.
- Understand how to use assessment FOR learning to support and increase student learning.
- Hear about scenarios of wise literacy practice from classes, schools and districts around the province.
- Have the opportunity to learn about specific applications of research and practice from provincial literacy mentors.
- Activate and refine my personal "mental model" of effective literacy teaching and learning.
- Leave with a plan for my next steps.
