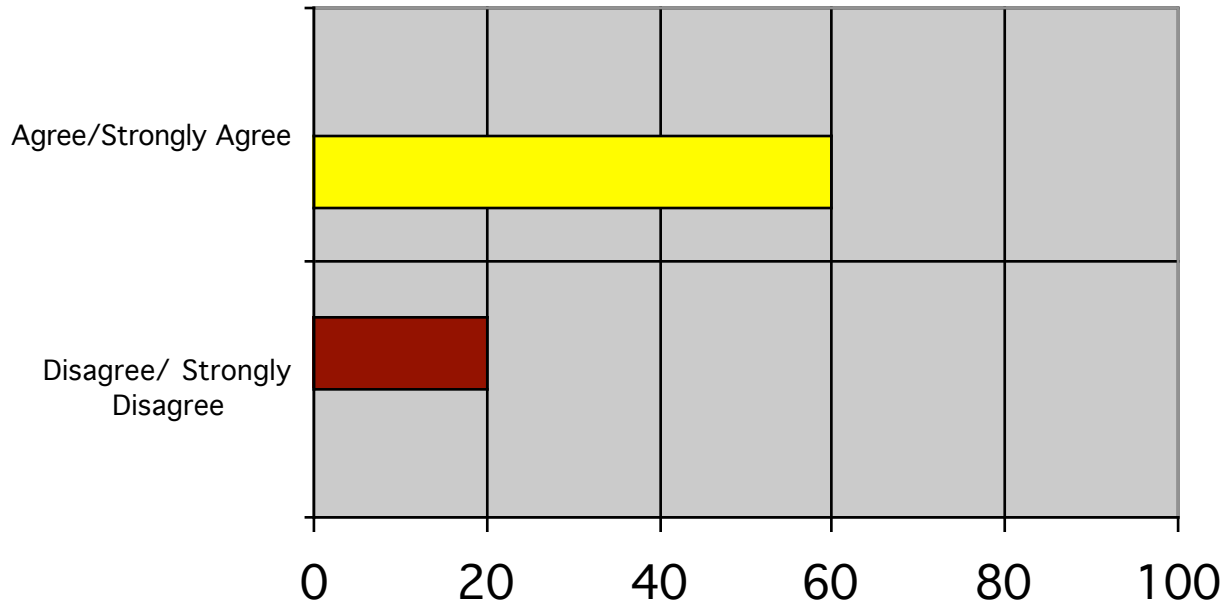


Four Day Week Bus Driver Survey Results

Compared to the five day week, students are more tired on the bus.



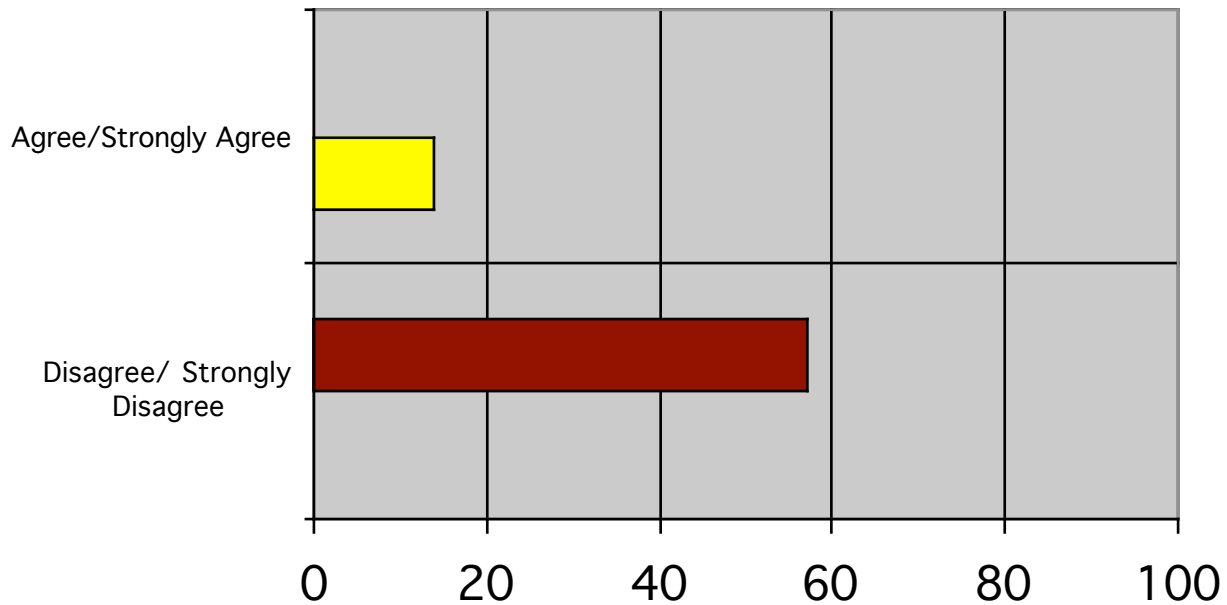

Students appear less stressed on my bus.



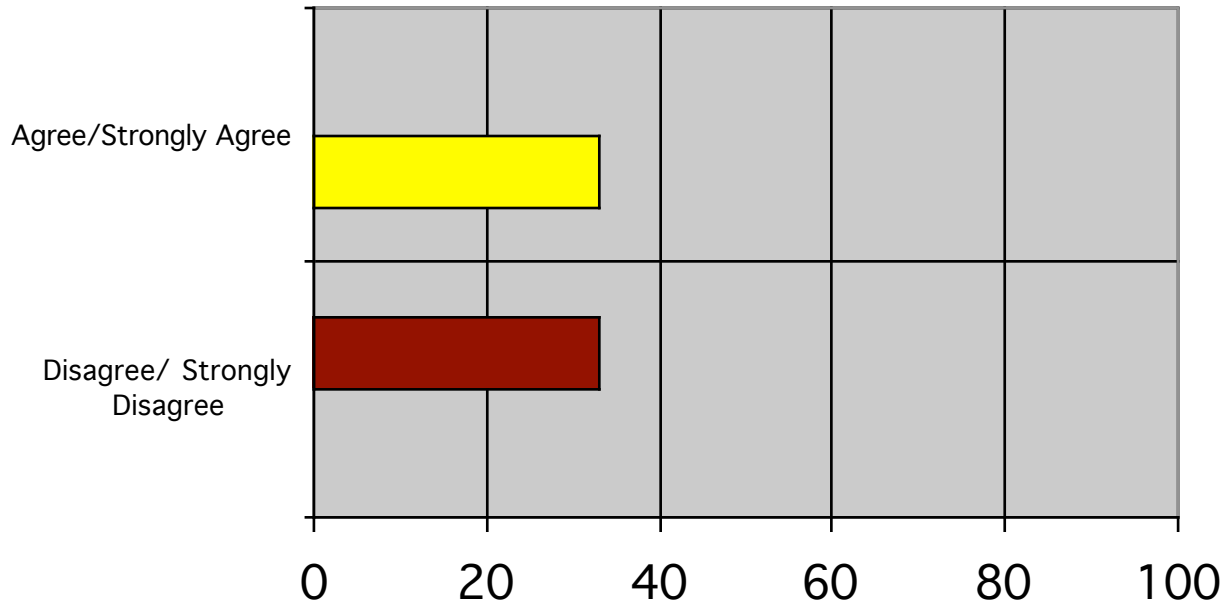

Compared to the five-day week, student behaviour on the bus is more disruptive.



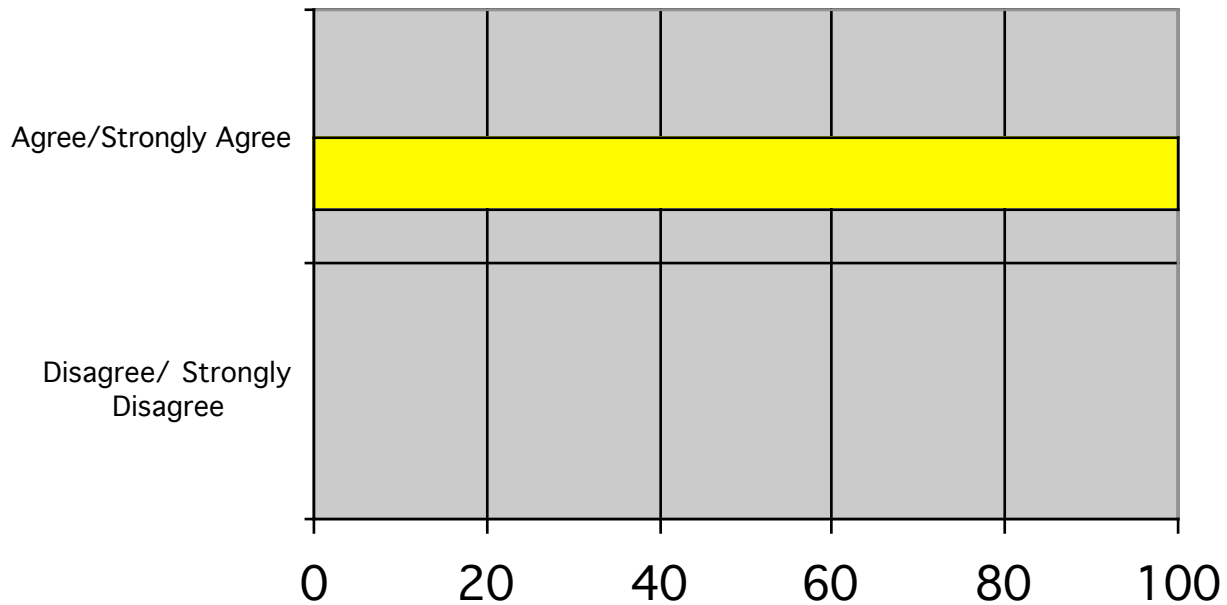

I have a sense of accomplishment and interest in my job.



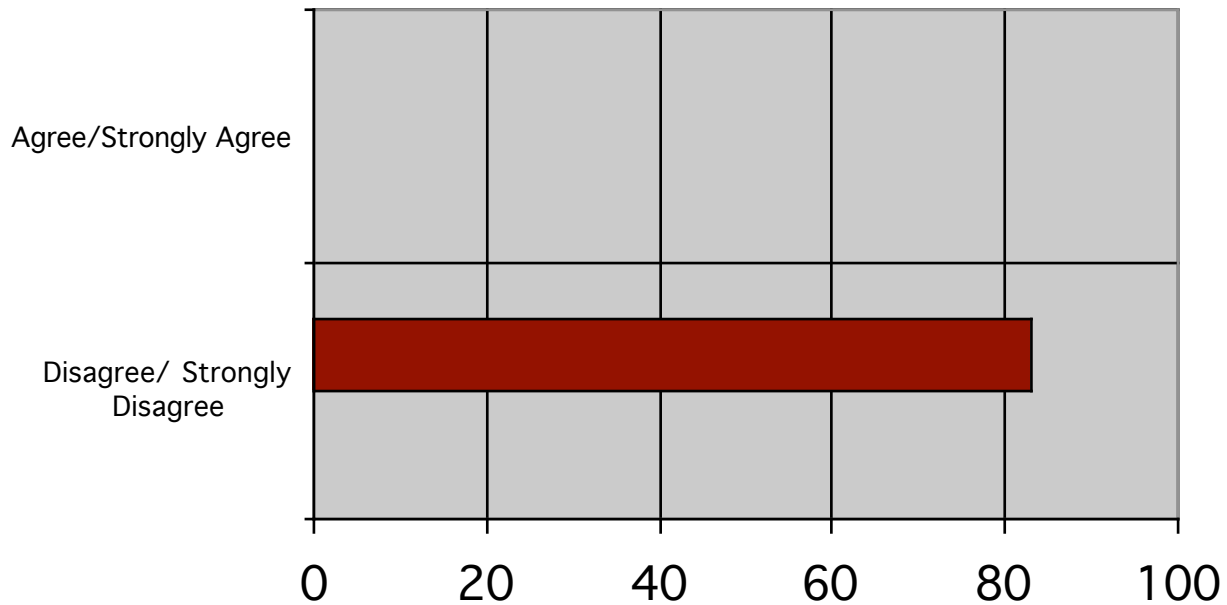

My job is less stressful this year.



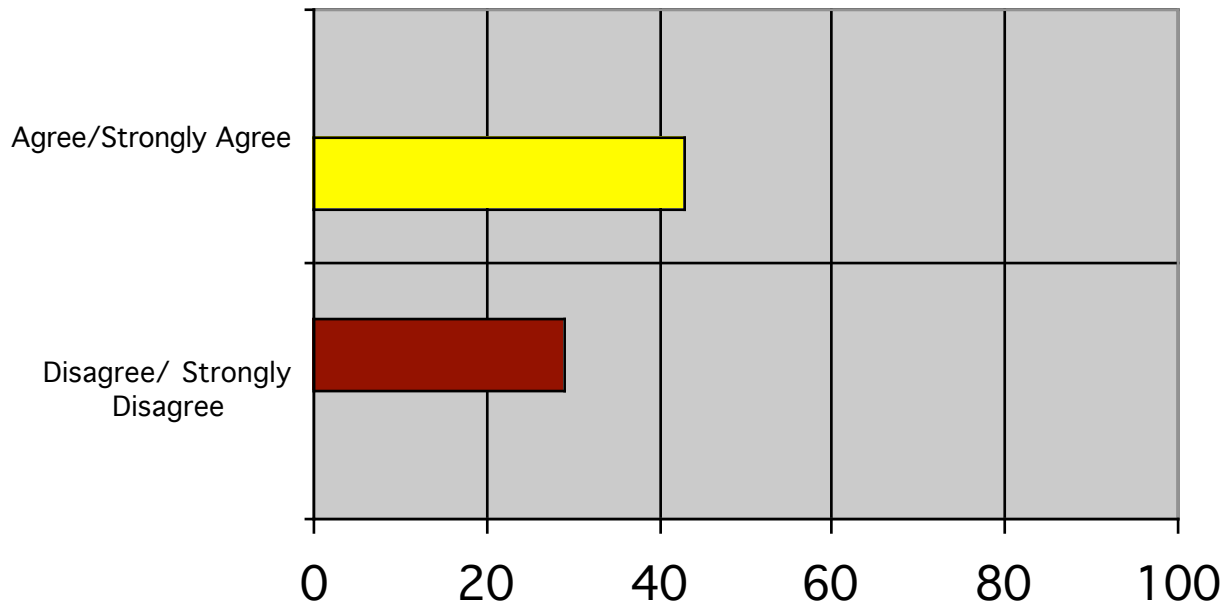

The amount of fatigue that I experience has increased.



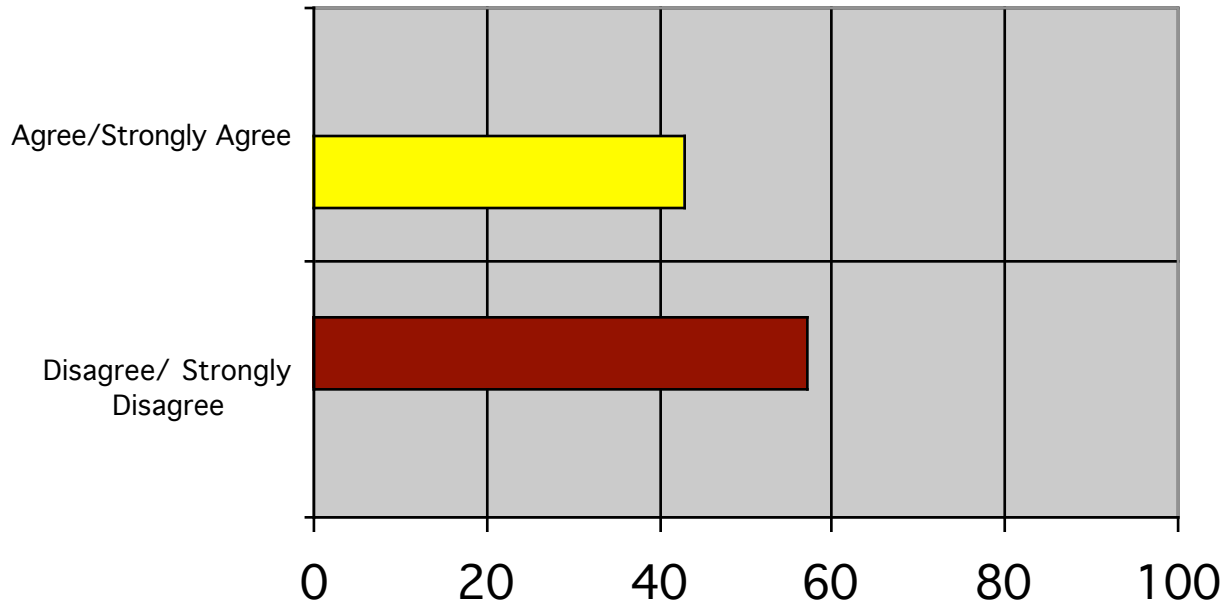

The number of students arriving late to the bus in the morning has increased.



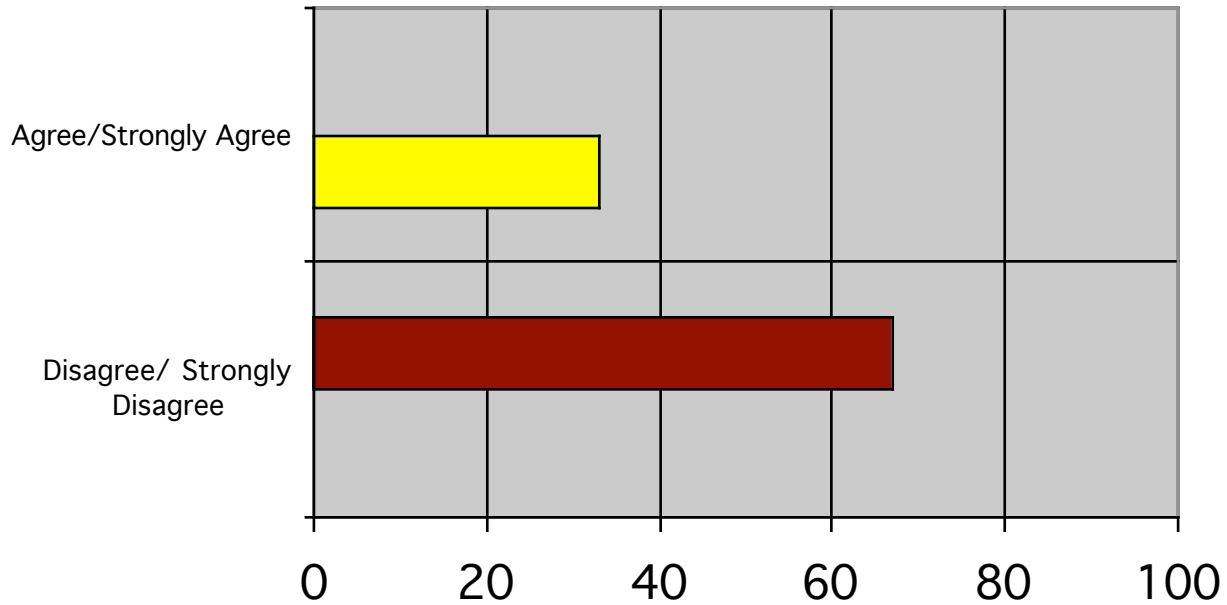
