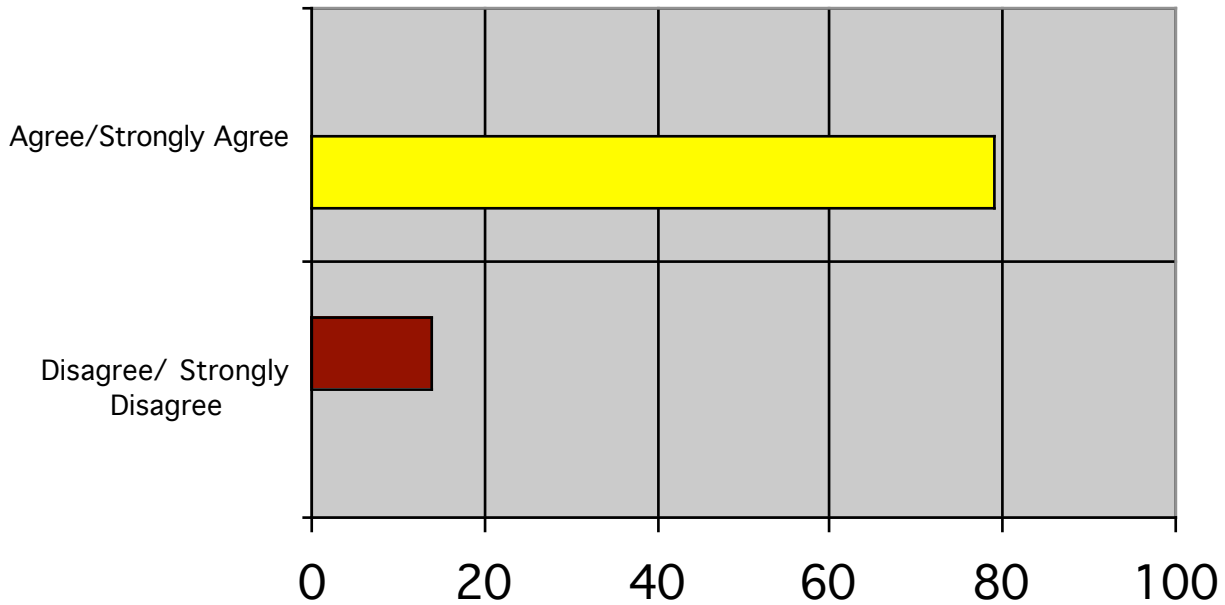


Four Day Week Parent Survey Results

Compared to the five-day week, my child is satisfied with school.



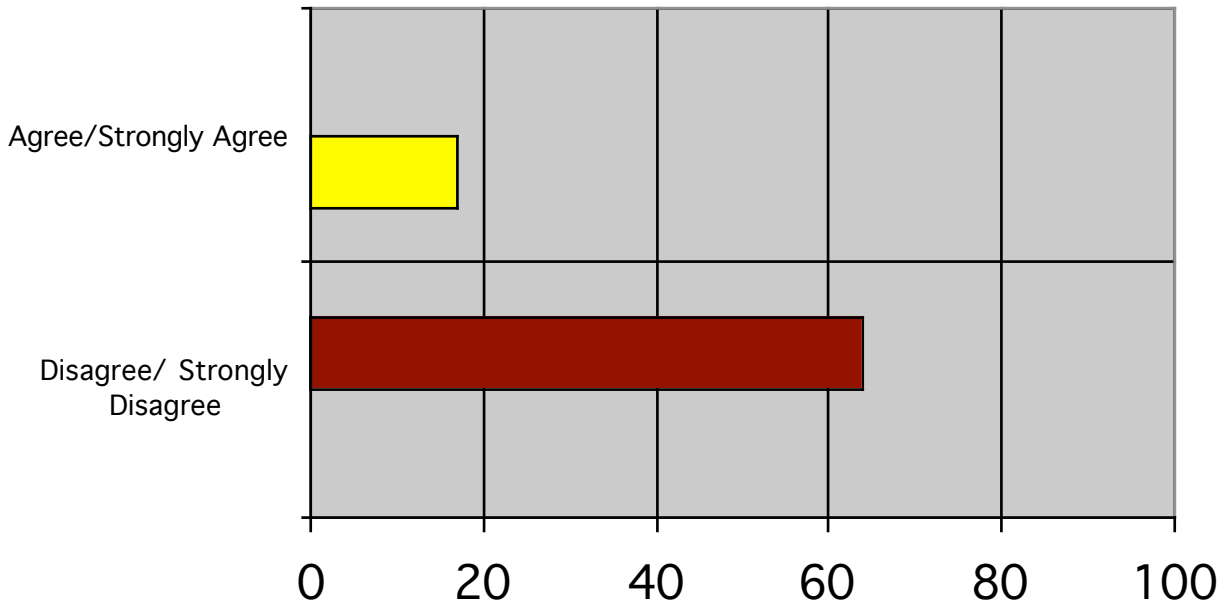

My child's achievement on tests and quizzes has dropped.



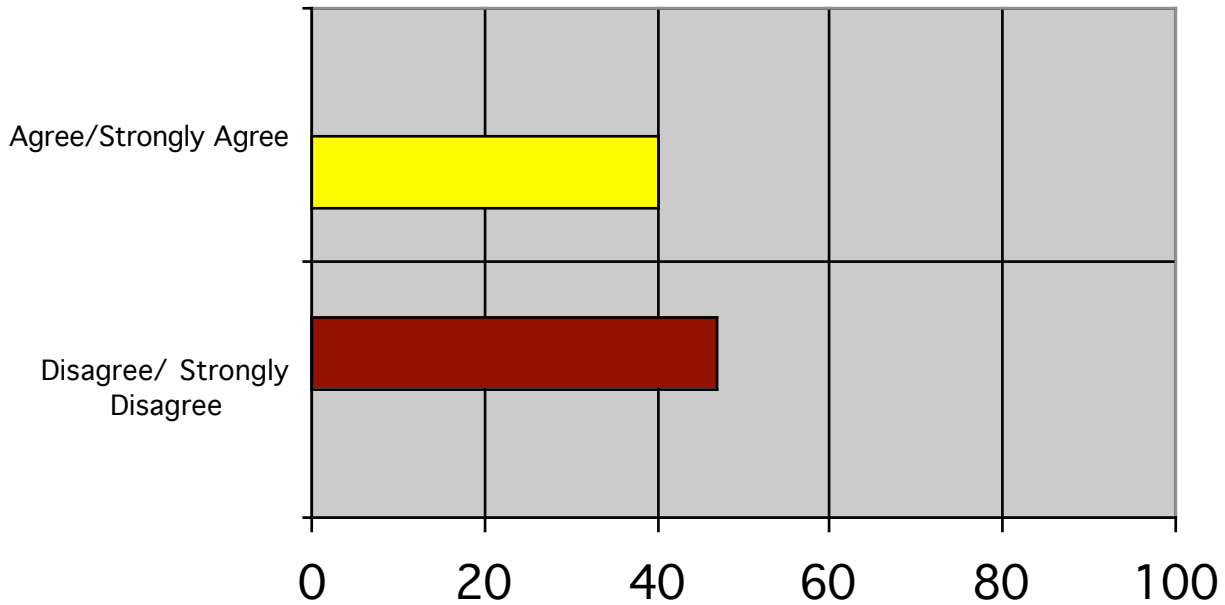

Compared to the five-day week, my child gets more tired in class.



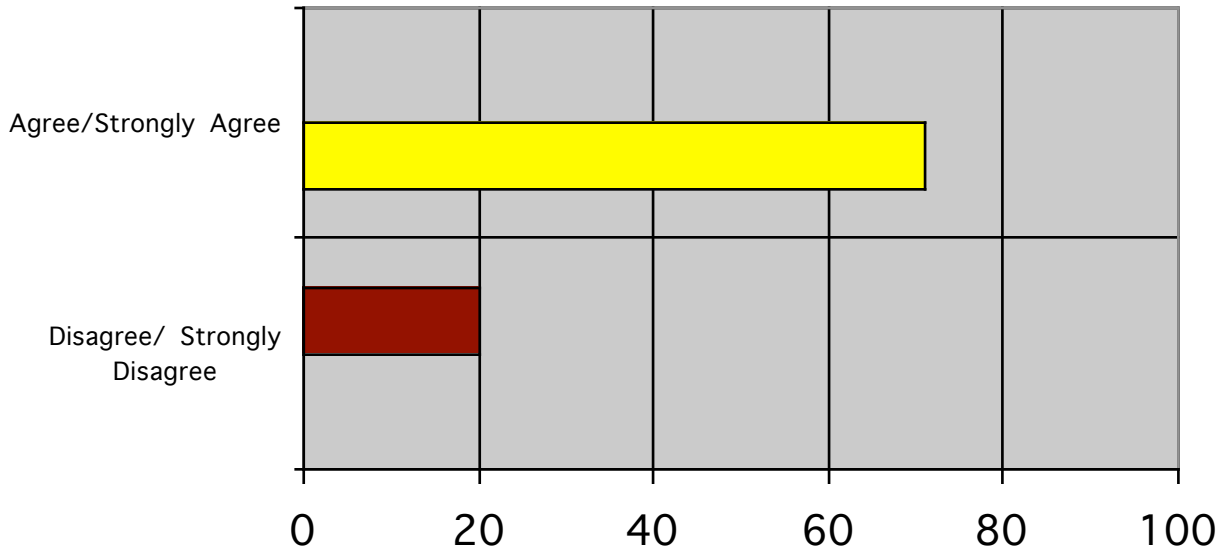

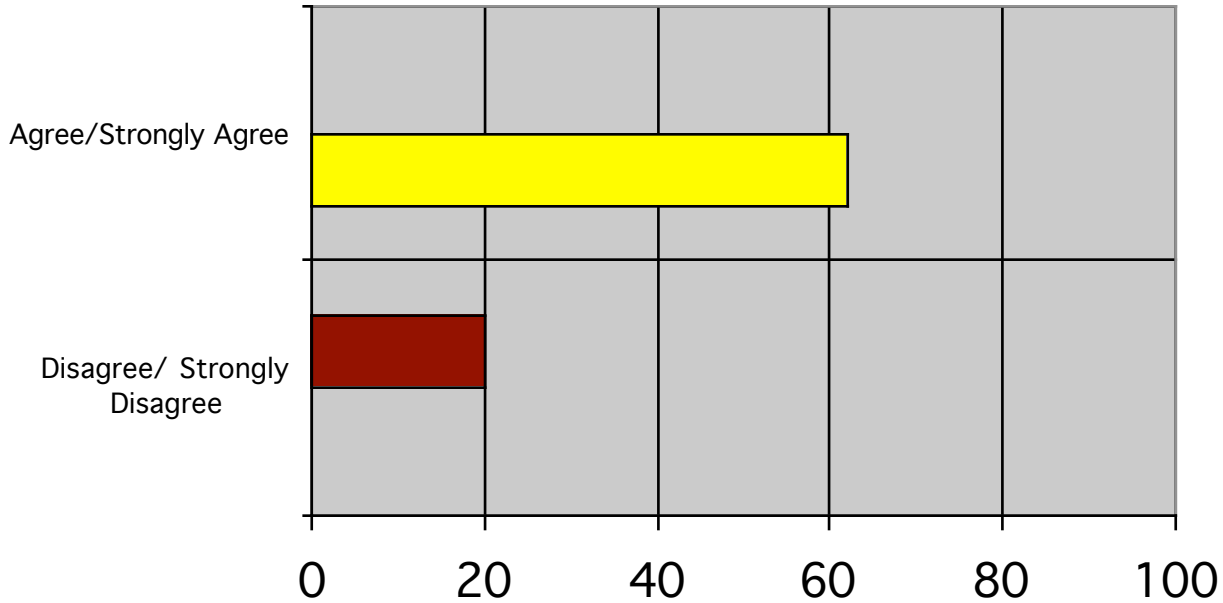

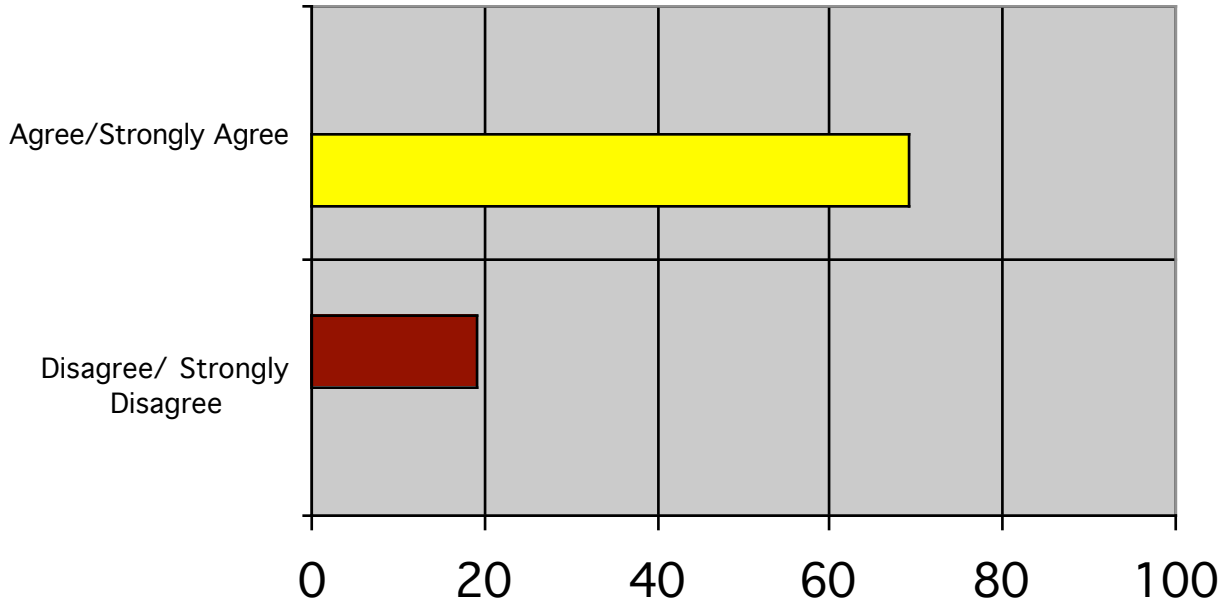

There is enough time for my child to participate in activities in the community.



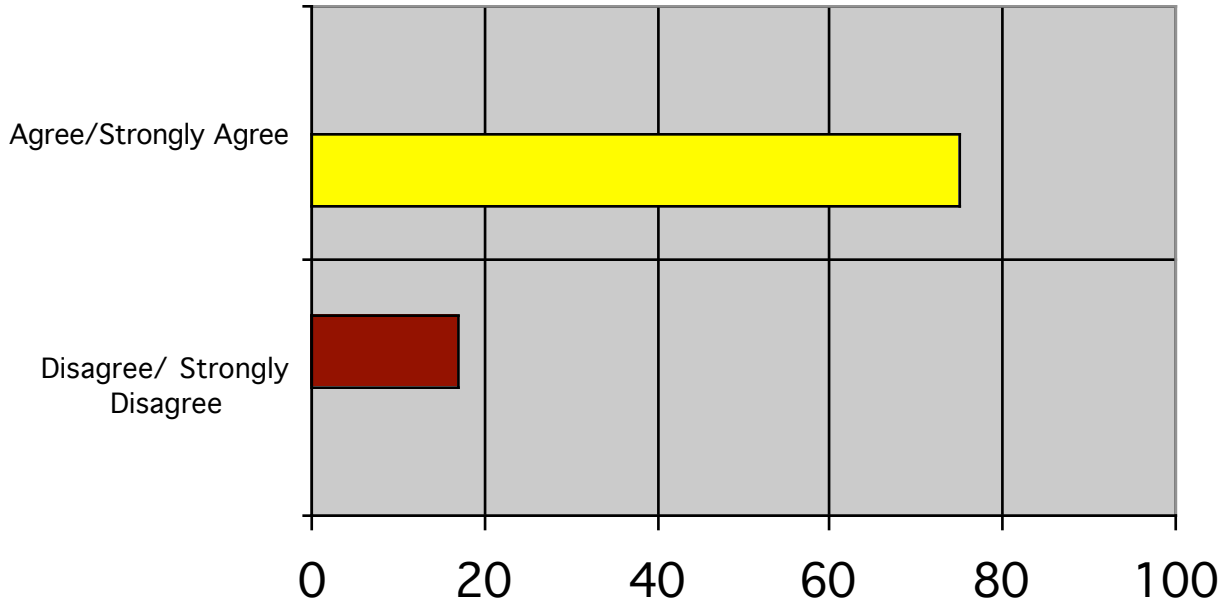

Compared to the five-day week, there is time for my family to spend together.



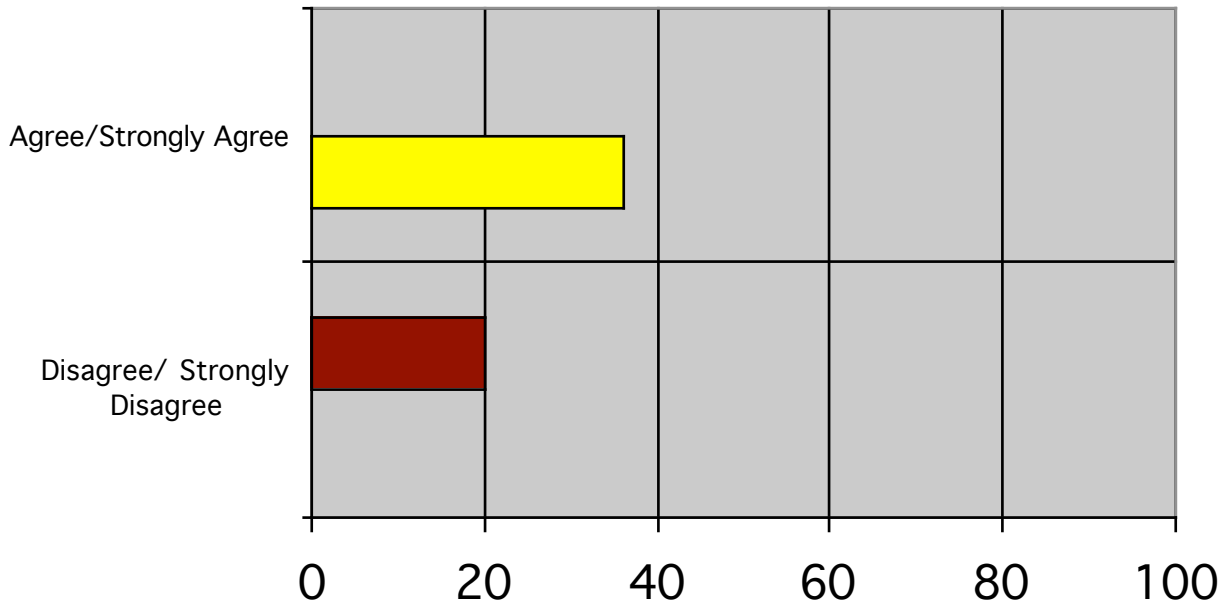

There is time for my child to get a part-time job.



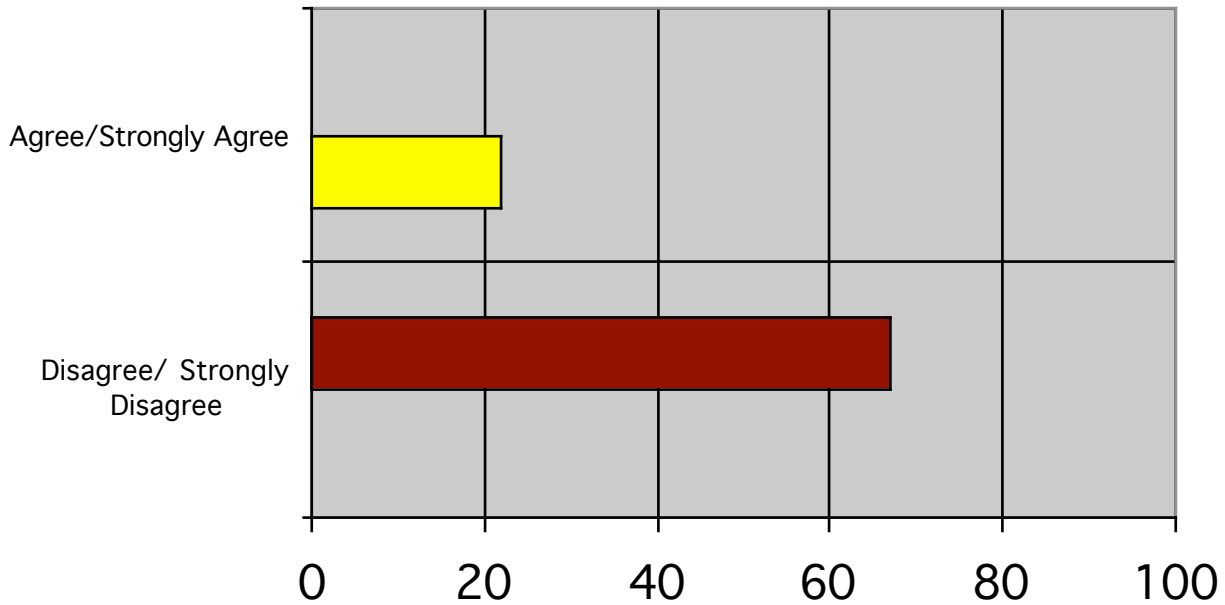

Compared to the five-day week, my child has less leisure time.



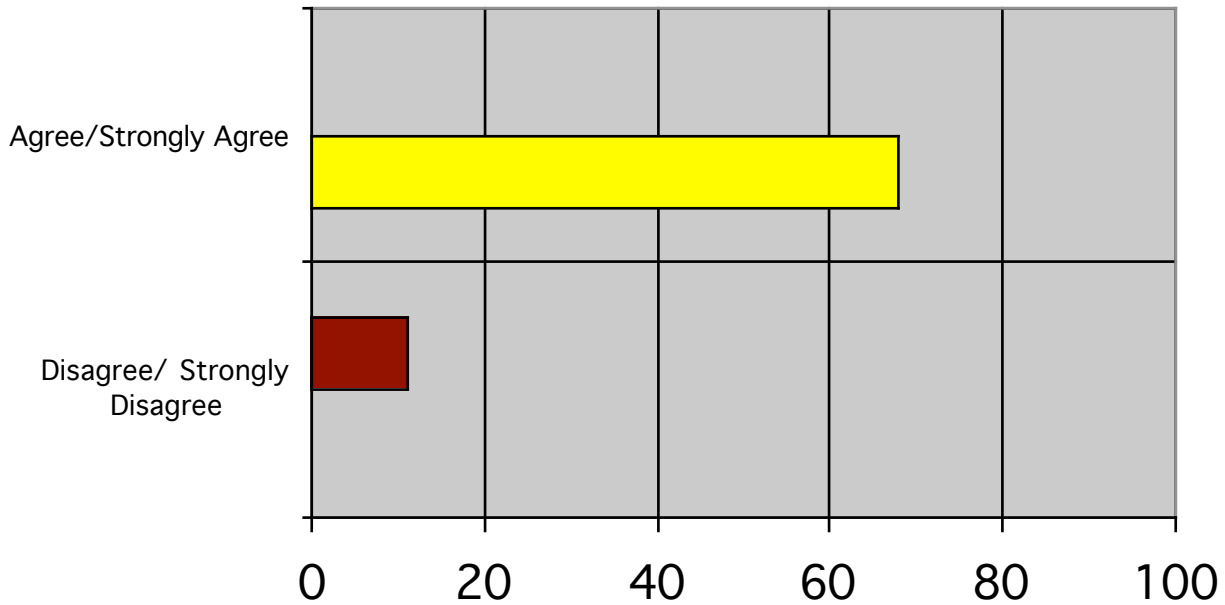

Our family has been able to meet our childcare needs.



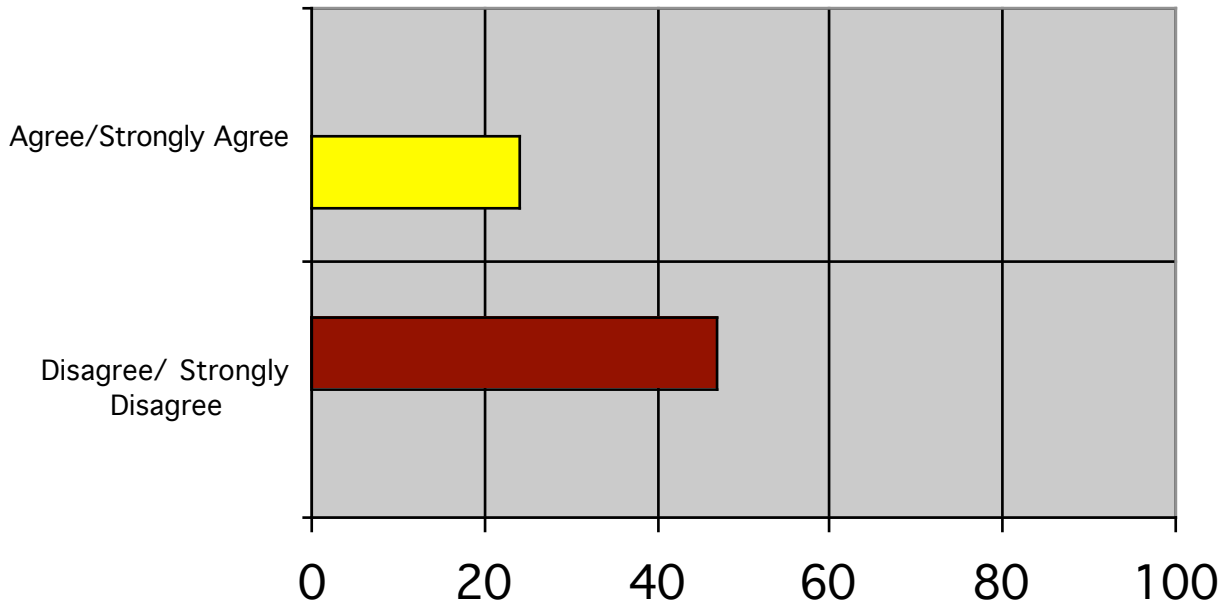

My family has additional childcare costs.



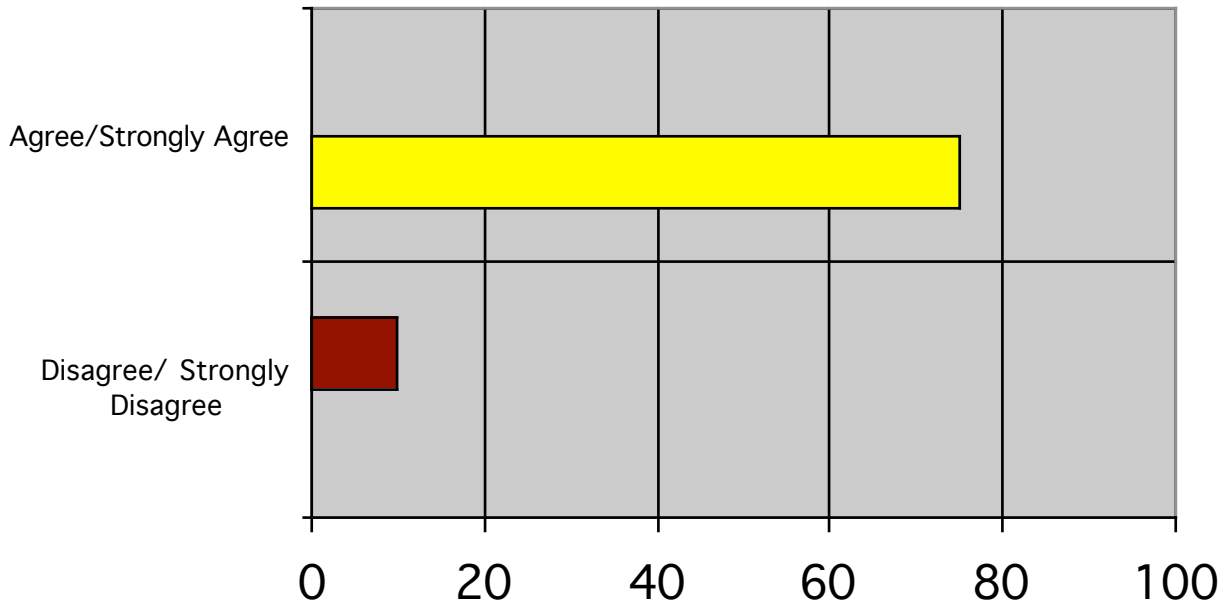

There is opportunity to meet with my child's teacher(s).



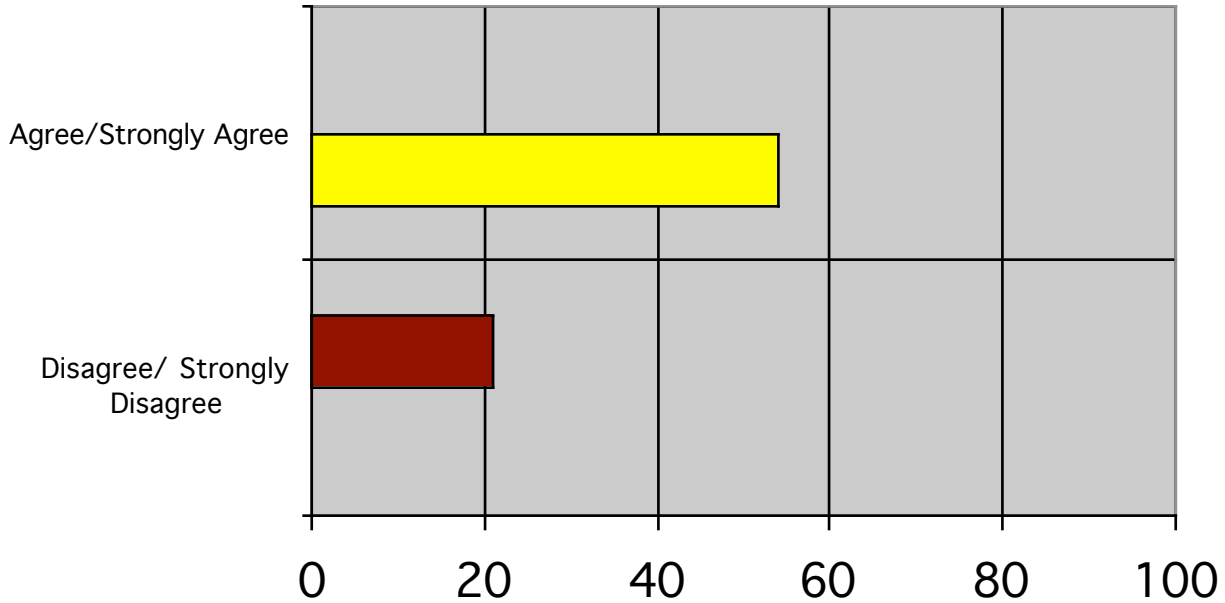
